

International Student Arrivals

Fully vaccinated eligible student visa holders can now travel to Australia without a travel exemption. Australia has welcomed the arrival of more than 80,000 International Students since the Australian Government <u>announced</u> that fully vaccinated eligible visa holders can enter Australia.

A <u>student visa fee waiver</u> is now available to student visa holders who are currently offshore and travel to Australia between 19 January and 19 March 2022.

International Education Resilience Fund (IERF)



The International Education Resilience Fund, delivered through Study Melbourne, supports Victorian universities with funding for their international student welfare and support services, improved delivery of remote and offshore teaching and learning and increased student engagement programs and events.

Global Victoria EdTech Innovation Alliance



In partnership with Edugrowth, Global Victoria is delivering the <u>Global Victoria EdTech Innovation Alliance</u>, awarding up to \$800,000 in major research grants to nine Victorian EdTech companies and their project partners, including funding for researchers and for capacity-building activities.

The Global Victoria EdTech Innovation Alliance supports partnerships between Victorian EdTech companies, education institutions, and international organisations, and enables cooperation to trial technologies that solve and enhance learning outcomes. The program road tests Victorian EdTech products in Australian and international education settings, in a structured formal framework, and will share the findings with the broader community.


